**Post-season tournament will run from May 29 through June 6**

**The following number of teams will make the playoffs:**

- Instructional League-No postseason for T-ball league**
- Mighty Mini Girls-All 4 teams single elimination.**
- Mighty Mini Boys-All 8 teams single elimination.**
- Mini Pee Wee Girls-All 4 teams double elimination**
- Mini Pee Wee Boys-6 teams or those at or above .500 double elimination.**
- Mite Girls-4 teams or those at or above .500 double elimination.**
- Mite Boys-4 teams or those at or above .500 double elimination.**
- Midget Boys-4 teams or those at or above .500 double elimination.**

**(We will use whatever number is largest to determine how many teams will make it to the playoffs). There will be no need for any tiebreakers.**

**Ties for any slot will be broken by the following tiebreakers. 1st-record against the other team and head to head if needed; 2nd-record against the other team and then flip a coin if needed. Slot determination is used only in seeding the tournament. If two or more teams are tied for a slot then the same rules apply.**
